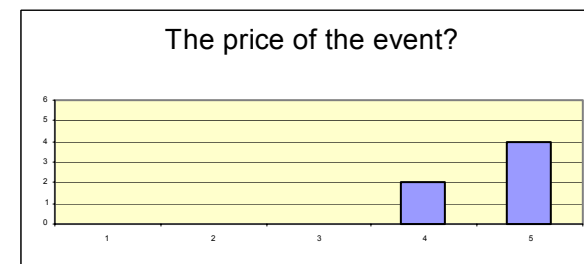
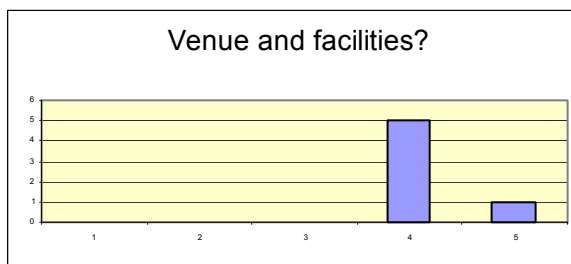
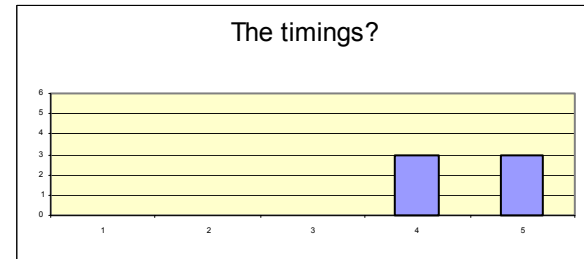
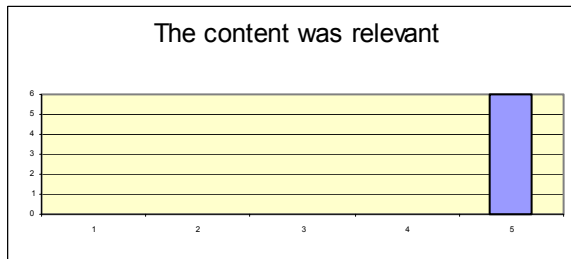
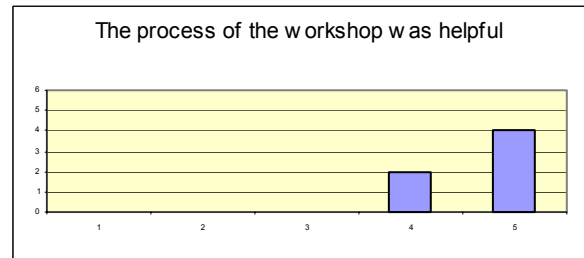
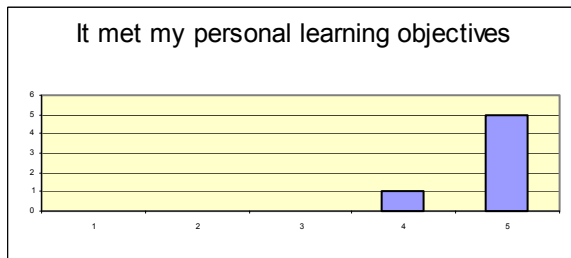


Course Evaluation – “Managing in the 21st Century; project, time and task management – fundamentals for advanced persons” 21st June 2006
