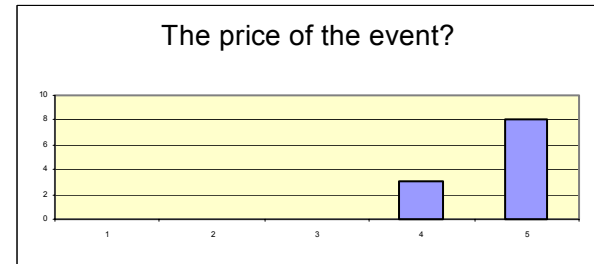
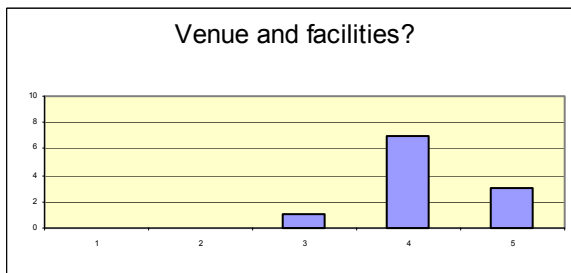
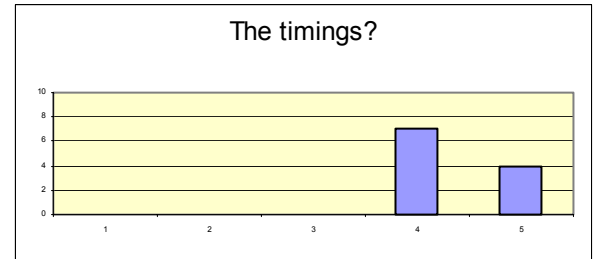
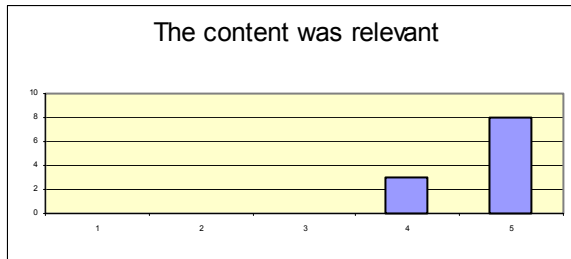
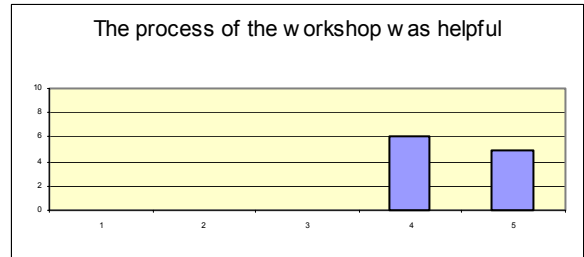
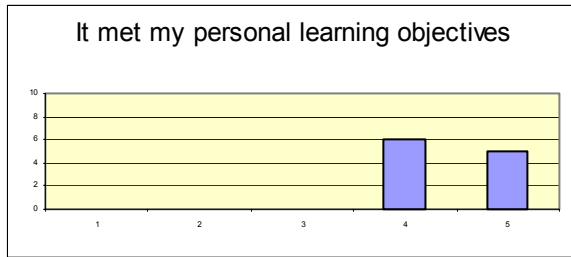


**Course Evaluation – “Maximising Impact – Personal Presentation Skills”
