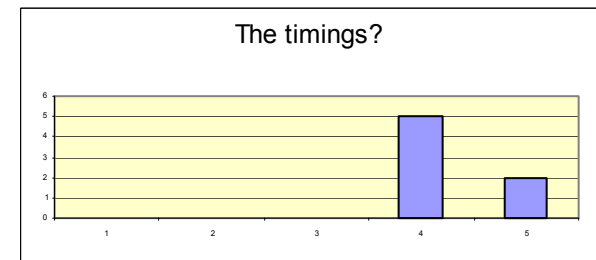
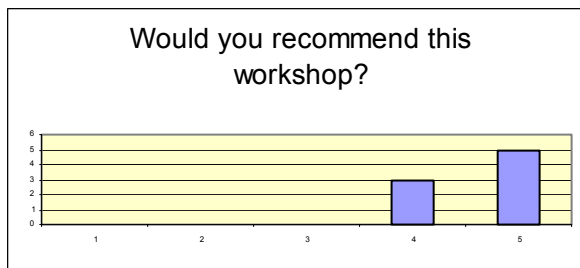
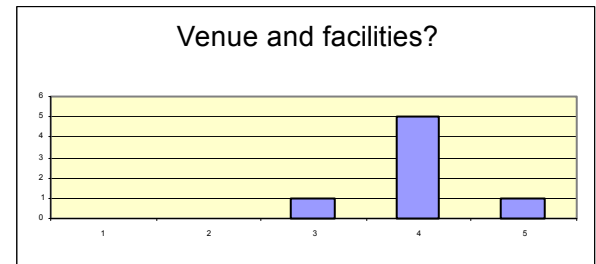
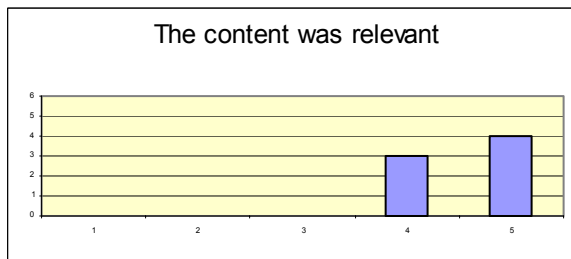
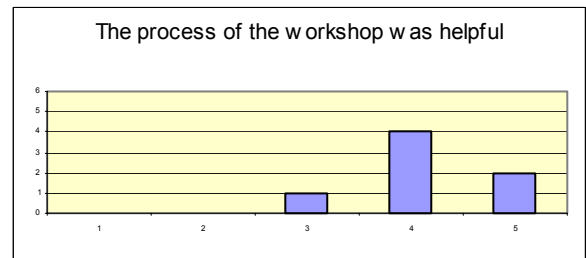
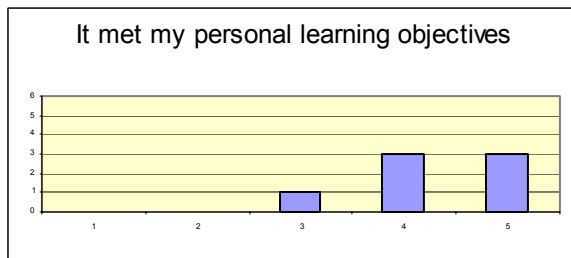


Course Evaluation – “Spreading Good Practice” London, March 2007
